SELECTION OF OUTSTANDING OLDER AMERICANS

OF HAWAI'I COUNTY FOR 2018

The Hawai'i County Office of Aging (HCOA), and the Mayor's Office, will honor outstanding older Americans of the County of Hawai'i during Older Americans Month on May 4, 2018. An Outstanding male and female Older American will be selected and will be honored at a State of Hawai'i function which will be held in Honolulu in June, 2018.

A. HCOA stated purposes of the selection and recognition of the Outstanding Older Americans in the County of Hawai'i:

1. To honor those seniors whose participation has contributed significantly toward the improvement of the quality of life in the community.
2. To encourage participation in a variety of activities in the community.
3. To encourage and recognize the development and exploration of new interests, endeavors, and accomplishments after reaching the age of 60.

B. Eligibility

1. Must be a resident of Hawai'i County.
2. Nominee must be 65 years or older prior to January 1, 2018.
3. Past Outstanding Older American Award winners are not eligible.
4. All nominations must have a "sponsor" other than the nominee herself/himself.
5. Individuals who wish to be selected to represent Hawai'i County at the Statewide Recognition event in June, 2018 must be present at the Hawai'i County luncheon on May 4, 2018.
